New York, NY (October 4, 2023) – The Winter Show’s 2024 edition brings together over 70 internationally renowned dealers in the fine and decorative arts, presenting museum-quality works from around the world, spanning 5,000 years from antiquity to today. Celebrating 70 years as the premier and longest-running art, antiques, and design fair in the United States, the Show will once again transform the historic Park Avenue Armory in New York City into an unmissable destination for collectors, connoisseurs, and enthusiasts. The 2024 edition will take place January 19–28. Special benefit events include the **Opening Night Party** on January 18 and **Young Collectors Night** on January 25. All proceeds from the Show’s benefit events and ticket sales fund the life-changing programs of East Side House Settlement.

The Winter Show is the only showcase of its kind, having been established in 1954 by its own beneficiary, **East Side House Settlement**, a community-based organization serving the Bronx and Northern Manhattan. For 70 years, The Winter Show has bolstered East Side House's mission to care for the individuals, families, and communities it serves by expanding opportunities through educational, job, and supportive services.

“In the 70 years that The Winter Show has shown in New York, it has consistently addressed the shifting role and value of art, antiques, and design within our communities,” said **Helen Allen, Executive Director of The Winter Show**. “We are thrilled to celebrate this momentous anniversary with returning presenters and patrons, while also welcoming new audiences to the Show and to the mission of East Side House. We are part of an exciting revival honoring objects that prioritize craftsmanship and style. More importantly, each presentation honors a story of the past and its continued legacy in the present moment. The Winter Show offers a platform for a generation with renewed interest in design led by storytelling, craftsmanship, and sustainability, and invites visitors to participate in an experience that also supports New Yorkers in need.”

Daniel Diaz, Executive Director of East Side House Settlement, said, “The Winter Show has long been a part of the East Side House tradition, and it is vital to raising the funds necessary to continue to serve those New Yorkers most in need. From January 19 through 28, 2024, **The Winter Show** returns to the Park Avenue Armory for its **70th Anniversary Platinum Jubilee Edition**. Since its beginning in 1954, the Show has established itself as the leading art, antiques, and design fair in America and a key event in the New York social calendar. The Winter Show supports the work of East Side House Settlement, a community-based organization serving the Bronx and Northern Manhattan. This year's Show celebrates the connections and love for art and design across generations, inviting new voices by saluting the heritage of objects past.

Internationally known for its rigorous vetting, the fair showcases over 70 of the world's top exhibitors in fine and decorative arts, offering works of the highest standards of authenticity and quality in the industry. Myriad works, from paintings, sculpture, works on paper, fine furniture, and design to jewelry, silver, rare books, and contemporary ceramics and glass, will be on view and available for purchase.

All revenues from the fair's general admissions and the net proceeds from the Opening Night Party and other special events benefit East Side House and contribute substantially to its robust community programming. No part of sales made by exhibitors is received by East Side House. The Winter Show runs January 19–28, 2024, at the Park Avenue Armory, 67th Street and Park Avenue, New York City. Hours of admission are Monday, Wednesday, Tuesday, and Friday, 12–8 PM; Thursday, 12–4:30 PM; Saturday, 12–7 PM; and Sunday, 12–6 PM. Daily admission is \$30 with early bird pricing and \$40 beginning in January. Prices include a copy of the Show's award-winning catalogue.

Corey Damen Jenkins & Associates is an internationally acclaimed interior design firm, recognized on the *Architectural Digest* AD100, the *ELLE Decor* A-List, and the 1stDibs 50. It has received industry honors including the 2023 ARTS Award for Interior Designer of the Year and the New York School of Interior Design's Larry Kravet Design Industry Leadership Award.

Ellen Hamilton is known for her curiosity and her effortless combinations of the historical and the contemporary. Her dedication to education, history, and community has taken form in the Brooklyn Heights Designer Showhouse, which she founded in 2017 to champion emerging talent and encourage intellectual curiosity in the design industry.

Alexa Hampton has been a leader in the design world since taking the reins of her father's iconic design firm in 1998. Hampton has contributed to her family's legacy of creating elegant, practical, and classically informed interiors for modern living. She was inducted into *Architectural Digest's* AD100 Hall of Fame in 2023, after 20 years of being regularly named to the AD100.

Peter Pennoyer is the founding partner of Peter Pennoyer Architects, whose work is characterized by sophisticated detail and high-quality craftsmanship, as well as its graceful

ability to balance comfort, beauty, modernity, and continuity with the past. A Fellow of the American Institute of Architects and an honoree of *Architectural Digest's* AD100, he is an author of five books on early-20th-century American architects, among others.
